Ages 2 and Under:

Ages 3 to 5:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Put away outside toys in proper places

- ❖ Water outside plants

Ages 6 to 9:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Sweep the patio and porches
- ❖ Wipe patio table and chairs
- ❖ Do easy yard work such as weeding
- ❖ Help wash the car

Ages 10 to 13:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Clean the patio and patio furniture
- ❖ Harvest vegetables
- ❖ Mulch plants
- ❖ Take compostable material to compost pile
- ❖ Cut flowers for the house
- ❖ Vacuum the pool once a week
- ❖ Polish silver

Ages 14 to 17:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Mow the lawn
- ❖ Clear away dead foliage

- ❖ Wash exterior windows
- ❖ Do yard work such as pruning
- ❖ Wash the car
- ❖ Maintain compost pile
- ❖ Touch up paint
- ❖ Dust door tops
- ❖ Wash doors/oil if wood

Adults:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Switch out bedding
- ❖ Organize pantry
- ❖ Wash pillows, blankets, throws
- ❖ Flip and rotate mattresses
- ❖ Wash outside furniture
- ❖ Clean ceiling fans and lights
- ❖ Clean carpets/rugs
