Winter Chores by Age

Ages 2 and Under:

- ❖ Pick up outside toys

Ages 3 to 5:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Put away outside toys in proper places
- ❖ Wash all baseboards (use an old sock)

Ages 6 to 9:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Wash blankets, throws and comforters
- ❖ Remove and wash floor vents

Ages 10 to 13:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Organize pantry and clean shelves
- ❖ Tighten all the screws in switch plates
- ❖ Wash blinds

Ages 14 to 17:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Vacuum behind appliances (with help to move them)
- ❖ Vacuum behind and under all furniture (with help to move furniture)
- ❖ Clean out fireplace and tools
- ❖ Wash curtains

- ❖ Wash pillows (replace synthetic every 1-3 years, memory form every 18-36 months, feather/down every 5-7 years)
- ❖ Rotate and flip mattresses
- ❖ Check doorknobs and tighten all screws
- ❖ Shovel driveway and side walks
- ❖ Shovel snow off deck

Adults:

Previous chores, plus:

- ❖ Change furnace filters
- ❖ Deep clean oven
- ❖ Inspect sump pump if you have one
- ❖ Divert septic tank if it is time
- ❖ Visually inspect your attic
- ❖ Inspect-annual termite inspection (get an expert)
- ❖ Test smoke and carbon monoxide and replace batteries
- ❖ Check the garage door
