

## ART SUPPLY SHOPPING LIST:

- Pick from the art medium options below.
- Choose something easy to work with so that this can be a fun process.
- Consider setting a budget before walking into the store.  
Art supplies can be so much fun and it's easy to get excited in the moment and buy more than you'll need.
- Michaels is a good choice to find all your supplies in one place.

### 1. Colored construction paper or another type of paper

- Colored paper (can be bought in mixed packets, or individual sheets)
- Pair of scissors that cuts well
- Glue stick
- Poster board or other surface as the background for your art

### 2. Paint

- Acrylic paints: can be bought in prepackaged sets or individual colors
- Set of 3 or more different size/shape brushes, appropriate for acrylic paint
- Palette paper (you might also have something disposable on hand to use such as a pie tin, a piece of plexiglass, or other smooth surface for putting out dabs of the different paint colors and mixing them)

### 3. Color Pencils

- Choose a prepackaged set or individual colors of pencils
- Drawing pad or notebook in the size you'd like to draw
- Eraser that works with colored pencils

### 4. Color Markers

- Choose a prepackaged set or individual colors of markers
- Poster board, drawing pad or drawing notebook in the size you'd like to draw

### 5. Oil Pastels

- Choose a prepackaged set of oil pastels
- Poster board, drawing pad or drawing notebook in the size you'd like to draw
